**WASHINGTON INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION
FOR A FAIR, SAFE AND NONDISCRIMINATORY PRACTICE IN ATHLETIC
AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

WHEREAS, in Washington State, The Washington Interscholastic Activities Association (WIAA) is a voluntary, nonprofit 503(c)(3) service organization. Its authority given under RCW 28A.600.200 by designation of school district's board of directors to control, supervise and regulate the conduct of interschool athletic activities and other interschool extracurricular activities of an athletic, cultural, social or recreational nature for the students of the district, subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, ----- School District has delegated the control, supervision and regulation of such activities to the Washington Interscholastic Activities Association (WIAA); and

WHEREAS, per RCW 28A.600.200 Finding – Intent- 2012 c 155: The legislature finds that the mission of the WIAA is to assist member schools in operating student programs that foster achievement, respect, equity, enthusiasm, and excellence in a safe and organized environment. The legislature intends to ensure that this mission is successfully carried out so that arbitrary sanctions that result in students unfairly being denied participate or cause students' achievements to be diminished do not occur; and

WHEREAS, physiological differences matter in athletic activities that demand physical characteristics such as, but not limited to, strength, endurance, stamina and body structure, which are inherently different for the biological form of males and females; and

WHEREAS, controversy and discrimination can impact all student athletes in adverse ways; and

WHEREAS, the ----School District is committed to understanding the perspectives and concerns of all stakeholders that reflect our shared values of fairness, inclusivity and respect; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS -----, ----- COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

1. The 2026 WIAA Proposed Amendment No.21, put forth by Lynden is supported.
2. In recognition of the authority granted by RCW 28A.600.200 for each school district board of directors to control, supervise, and regulate the conduct of interschool athletic activities and other interschool extracurricular activities, voting members are strongly encouraged to vote in support of 2026 WIAA Proposed Amendment No. 21.
